

UOW Early Admission Interviews

Interview Tips

Interviews will be held on the Wollongong campus between 30 September – 2 October. The interview is your chance to show us you have the qualities needed to be a successful UOW student.

Dress for the occasion. You should treat UOW Early Admission interviews like a job interview. You don't need to wear a suit or formal business attire, but smart, neat clothing is recommended.

Read your instructions careful and supply all the information requested. Prepare and be punctual. For more interview tips, watch our <u>interview tips video</u>.

Arriving on Campus

UOW's Wollongong campus is a pretty big place—so we recommend giving yourself plenty of time to get to the campus, find a parking spot (if needed) and make your way to your interview location. We have attached a campus map to help you find your way around. Parking is \$3.30 for up to 4 hours, so bring your coins for the machine.

There will be an Early Admission Meeting Point in Building 20. If you are unsure of where you need to be for your interview, just make your way to Building 20 and we'll point you in the right direction, check out our <u>campus map</u>.

What you need to bring

The most important thing you need to bring to your interview is proof of the results you entered in your application. We will need to keep this proof, so please ensure you have certified copies (refer to page 21 of the Early Admission Application Guide for more information) to leave with us—we can't take your original documents. You will need one set of copies for each interview you attend. This means if you have three interviews, you'll need three certified copies.

While you don't need to provide any additional information, you may wish to bring along some of the following documents to your interview:

- Trial HSC results if these were not included in your application
- Written references
- Visual images of your major works if they relate to the course you are applying to



Need more information about UOW
